The Children's Book Market in China



According to the 2019 Chinese Retail Book Market Report issued by OpenBook, the overall Chinese book retail market was valued in 102.27 billion CNY, up 14.4% year on year. Children's books account for 26.05% of the total sales of books, up 17.2% year on year.

China has a huge appetite for children and young adults' books. Over **40,000** new children's titles are published every year in China. This is by far the largest figure in the world. China has **367 million** children and young adults. More than **800 million** books are printed every year, and there are nearly **300,000 titles** targeting young readers currently on the market.

China also boasts a growing children's book market, which is tied to the steadily rising number of middle-class families. One of the defining traits of these families is a greater commitment to encourage their children to read, which has propelled book sales. It has also become easier than ever for parents to buy books through retail websites such as JD.COM, Dangdang and Tmall.

This rapid growth is helped by the Chinese Central Government's introduction of the two-child policy. With an increasing fertility rate, the number of potential young readers will also rise. A new generation of educated and well-read parents also contributes to the growth of the children's book market in China.

Launched in 2013, CCBF has quickly become an important event for the global publishing industry.

Over its seven years of development, CCBF has focused on accomplishing its moto—Embracing the Future. The fair provides a leading copyright exchange hub for children's books. It plays an important role in promoting quality children's literature and encourages reading culture among young children.

In 2018, CCBF opened an exciting new chapter by collaborating with Bologna Children's Book Fair (BCBF) organised by BolognaFiere. With a history of over 50 years, the BCBF is the largest children's literature fair in the world. This thriving cooperation will better serve the current strategy of China's publishing industry—disseminating original content worldwide and bringing the best international books to local readers—also known as the "go global, bring in" policy.

CCBF 2019 unfolded over a record space of **25,000** square metres and brought together **418** exhibitors and **102** guests from **32** countries and territories, including **186** overseas exhibitors and **57** overseas guests. Over three days, CCBF received a record number of **40,978** visitors, which include publishers, literary agents, authors, illustrators, translators, graphic designers, content developers, packagers, printers, distributors, booksellers, mobile developers, licensors and licensees, education and training institutions, cultural institutions, librarians, professional medias, teachers and children's book lovers.

Other than the exhibition itself, the fair offers a rich programme of events. Some of the most notable activities include the Conferences & Seminars, the Shanghai Visiting International Publishers Fellowship (SHVIP), the Golden Pinwheel Young Illustrators Competition, the Illustrators Survival Corner, the Children + Exhibition, the Chen Bochui International Children's Literature Award, and many other events to promote reading.

Accompanying Programmes

Conferences and Seminars

CCBF is well–known for its numerous professional seminars covering a wide array of topics and formats such as panels on business practices, reading promotion, and creative workshops with children's book masters. Speakers include experts on publishing, digital marketing, social media, and content creation. These events aspire to promote communication and cooperation between professionals and share the latest children's literature industry trends with all attendees. In 2019, 10 sessions featured 61 top speakers and attracted 3,000 attendants.











Shanghai Visiting International Publishers Fellowship (SHVIP)

SHVIP is the CCBF publishers fellowship, an exchange programme designed for publishing managers, publishers and editors of all levels who have a special interest in selling and buying rights on the publishing markets of China and its Asian neighbours. For six days, SHVIP offers a small group of children's book specialists a tailormade programme of visits to gain detailed insight into the local publishing landscape and visit CCBF from an exclusive perspective.

In 2019, SHVIP received a ground-breaking number of applications—**165** requests from **56** countries and territories—and hosted **11** members participated in a 6-day exchange in Shanghai.

The next call for applications will run from **2 March** until **18 May 2020**.











Golden Pinwheel Young Illustrators Competition & Exhibition

The Golden Pinwheel aims to build bridges between illustrators and children's publishers, both domestically and globally. It is a comprehensive programme which includes exhibitions, an illustrated yearbook and a variety of promotional campaigns. It fosters an inspiring and nurturing environment where young illustrators and children's book artists from around the world find a platform to realise their visions.

In 2019, talented artists from every corner of the planet have poured their enthusiasm into the competition with submissions by **1,999** illustrators from **72** countries and territories.

The next call for entries will run from late March until **30 June 2020**.











Illustrators Survival Corner

The Illustrators Survival Corner is a programme featuring interactive workshops and seminars exclusively designed for illustrators, picture book editors and anyone professionally interested in the fascinating world of illustrated children's books. It is also a place where novices and seasoned professionals of the visual communication world can share experiences, successes and concerns regarding the profession and the market.

At CCBF 2019, the Illustrators Survival Corner featured an augmented programme of **10** masterclasses, **8** workshops and **40** portfolio reviews, with **90** tutors and speakers, which attracted about **1,800** illustrators.











Children + Toddlers' Books

In 2019, CCBF launched "Children +", a new stream of events aiming to cast light on a trend, a topical subject, a book category or a theme of special relevance for the global publishing industry. Through exhibitions, lectures, round tables and books presentations, we will discover and rediscover the most fascinating titles published in that category, and hear the best publishers and authors who created them. Every year, Children + will identify a different category of books—relevant from both international and local perspectives—to become a highlight of the CCBF programme.

The 2020 edition of Children + will focus on toddlers' books.











Chen Bochui International Children's Literature Award (CICLA)

The Chen Bochui International Children's Literature Award (CICLA) is one of the longest–running literary prizes in China, which receives CCBF support as promotion partner. Founded in 1981 by the Shanghainese children's writer Chen Bochui (1906–1997), the CICLA honours authors, illustrators and professionals of children's literature who have made a great contribution to children's literature in China and the rest of the world.

Every year in November, a Jury composed by a multicultural panel of children's literature specialists meets in Shanghai to assess the best contents submitted in the Award's main categories—Best Novel in Chinese Language, Best Short Story in Chinese Language and Best International Picture Books.











Exhibitors' Events and Connecting the City

CCBF is not only a meeting point for professionals of the children's publishing and education industries, it is also an annual celebration of the power and joy of reading. During the fair, our exhibitors, as well as numerous local bookstores, libraries, schools and other educational institutions organise a wide variety of cultural activities for readers to connect with books and interact with their favourite authors.

Connect the City turns Shanghai in a children's book feast for children's book enthusiasts of all ages.

During CCBF 2019, a total of **309** book releases, promotions and signing activities took place inside and outside of the fair.

2019 Exhibitors Review

CCBF 2019 has gathered even greater international resources by bringing together **418** top exhibitors from **32** countries and territories. Among them, **30**% exhibited at CCBF for the first time. Children's books publishing agencies and professionals from both home and abroad have carried out negotiations on children's books copyright trade extensively and successfully.





2019 Promotion Review

CCBF 2019 teamed up with major mainstream media, professional media and public media to conduct in-depth and comprehensive coverage of the fair.

A total of **198** media to cover CCBF 2019 including 22 industry media, 7 of them are the international media from the USA, France, UK, Japan, Russia and Australia.

The type of media includes 35 social media, 29 newspapers and magazines, 12 TV/broadcast/video media organisations and 154 online media.

A total of 586 articles have been published. 30 press conducted 54 onsite interviews.

The total media value reached 25.81 million CNY.
